

Equipment List for Carter Notch Trip, January 2012

Backpack

Sleeping Bag - good to 0 degrees or lower (rent a warmer bag if you don't think its warm enough)

Fleece/wool blanket / bag liner

Winter Jacket

Wool sweater or Fleece

Winter Hat

Face Mask or Scarf

Winter Boots – Sorrel type boots with removable inner liner

Raingear

Complete change of WARM !!! clothes (No cotton), including:

Long pants - fleece, wool, ski pants, etc.

2 T-shirts

1 long sleeve shirt

2 pr. socks of each type Wool outer layer and polypro inner layer
underwear

2 pair Thermal underwear - NOT COTTON

2 prs of gloves (Mittens are better) an extra pair of both would be best

Small Flashlight With new batteries in it

Band-Aids

Toilet paper

Paper towels

Garbage bags or pack cover to fit over pack

Toothbrush and paste

Mess kit (cup, bowl, fork, knife, and spoon)

2 Water bottles - wide mouth (1 quart each)

Matches

Stove (if you have one)

Snacks

Sunglasses

Heat pads

Daypack

Optional:

Snowshoes

Plastic Sled - full size - not a tube or roll up type.

Camera

PACK AS LIGHT AS POSSIBLE REMEMBER : You Pack it You carry it! But don't skip on clothes

PACK EVERYTHING IN PLASTIC BAGS Put a large garbage bag in your pack and put everything into it.

Don't forget shower stuff & clean clothes (to be left in car – in a small daypack or bag) - for after the trip.
